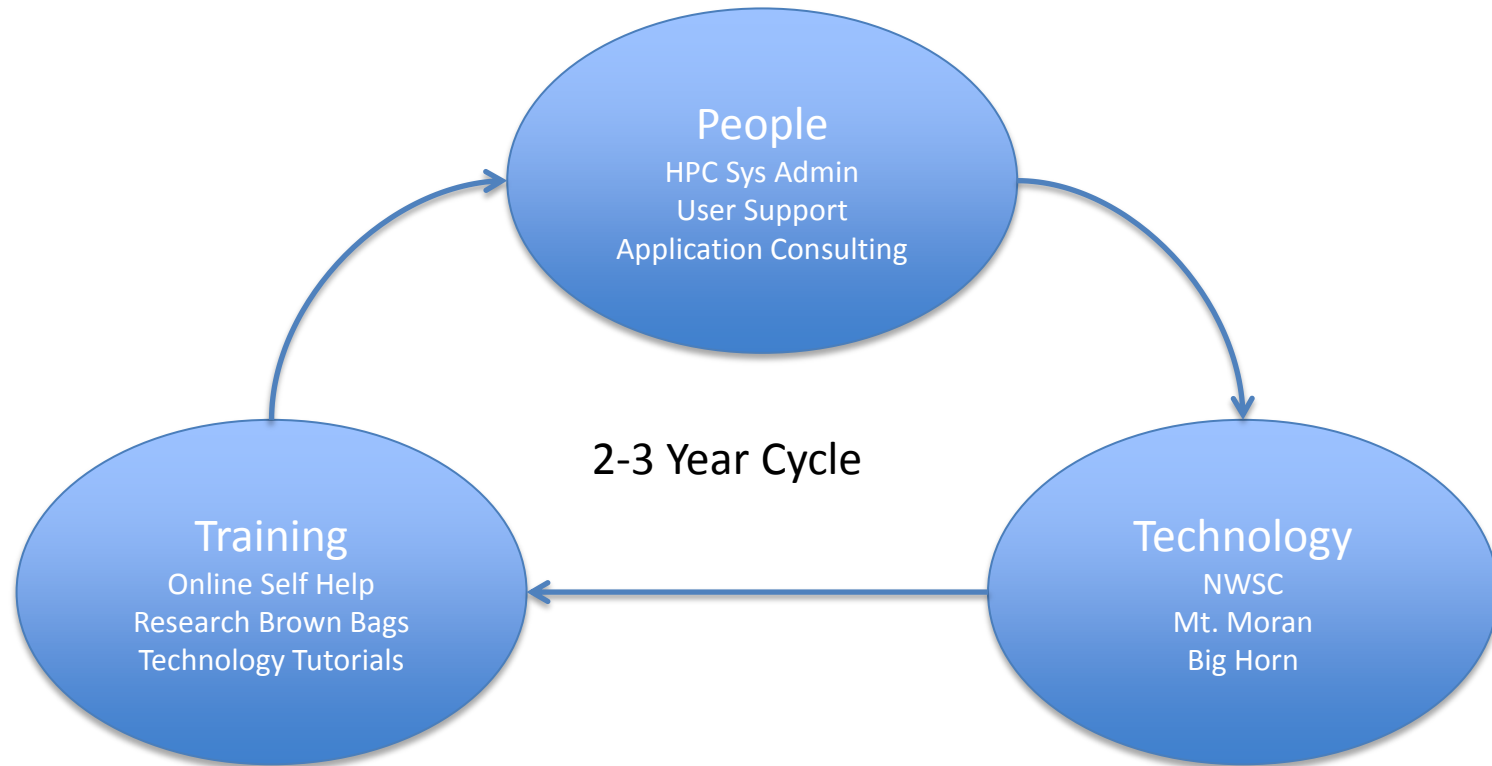

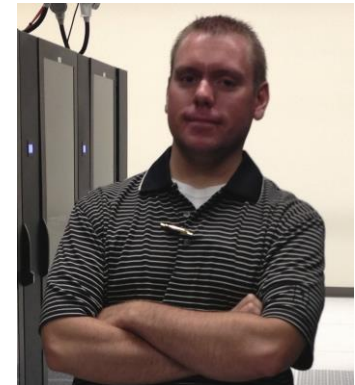

Technology

- NCAR Wyoming Supercomputing Center (NWSC)
 - Yellowstone Supercomputer (75,000 cores), DAV Cluster and Storage
 - UW has access to 20% of the NSF Funded Portion of resource
 - All applications are peer reviewed
- Mt. Moran
 - High Performance Computing Cluster
 - Condo Model
 - Over 3000 cores
 - Mix of CPU and GPU Nodes
 - Infiniband Interconnect
- Big Horn
 - High Performance Storage System
 - 425+ TB Usable Storage
 - GPFS File System



Training

- Online Documentation including Faculty blog is dominant training tool.
- Researchers present results during bi-weekly brown bag presentations
- ARCC staff presents short (90 minutes) technical tutorials. E.g.
 - Intro to Linux
 - Intro to HPC
 - Intro to NWSC and the ARCC
 - HPC with the Macintosh



Funding Model

- Initial
 - Wyoming State Start Up Funds (\$2M)
 - Contributions from Researchers and Grants (NSF & DOE) (\$2M)
- Recurring
 - Commitment of \$1M/Year from University's President and Research Office
 - Commitment of \$1M/Year from State to Fund Wyoming share of NWSC
- Current Discussions
 - Per Year Satellite Cluster Management
 - Rent a Consultant
